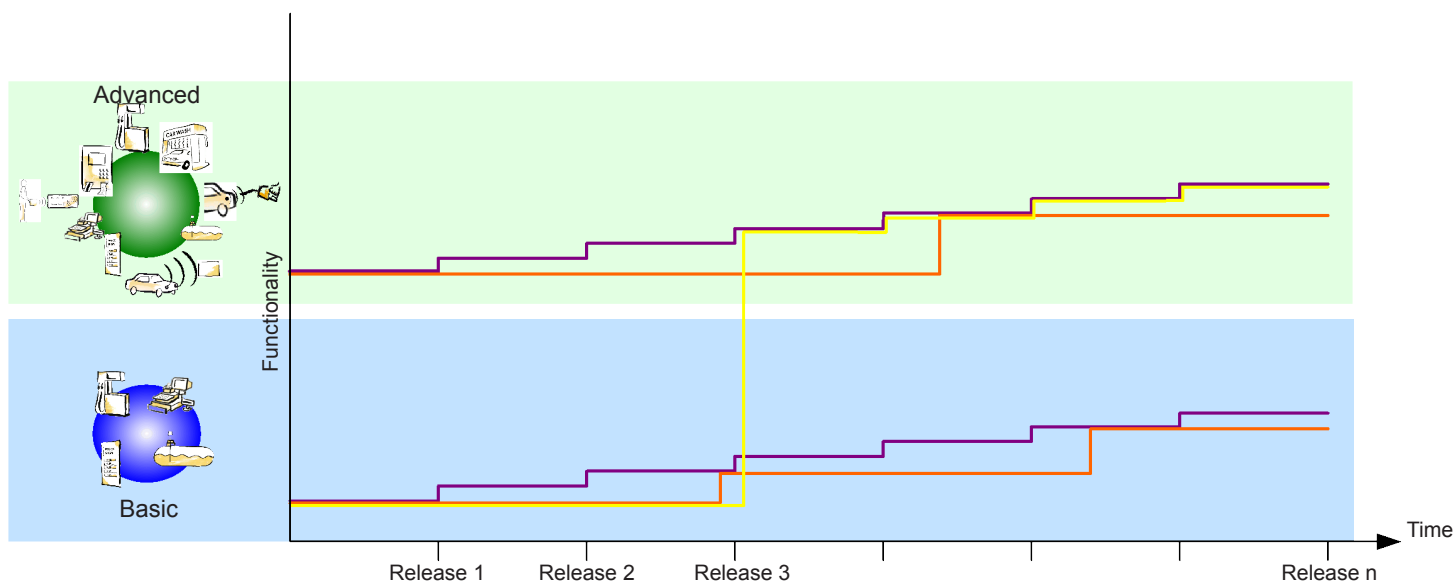


PSS 5000 Software

Application Software Versions and Maintenance

The PSS 5000 has 2 software versions: Basic and Advanced. New releases for each of these are available on a regular basis. The diagram below illustrates the release patterns of these versions and how updates and upgrades can occur. More details about these are provided on the next page.



Planned Updates

The purple path shows how having a Maintenance Agreement automatically provides you with regular updates, which contain the latest protocol implementations and often include added functionality.

Ad hoc Updates

The orange path shows that even without a regular maintenance plan you can still purchase an update that, at the time of purchase, updates your system with the latest protocols and released improvements.

Upgrades

The yellow path shows how you can take your original basic functionality and then upgrade it to provide advanced functionality and also implement a regular maintenance update plan.

Standard Practice

Doms is continually developing its PSS 5000 Application software. This can, for example, involve implementing new protocols, adding new functionality or fixing bugs. Because of this, updates of the Application software are not automatically distributed free of charge outside of the warranty period. However, updates can be purchased either directly or via a PSS 5000 Software Maintenance Agreement.

Standard Software Warranty

If you experience a software error with your PSS 5000 Application software within 6 months of your purchase, Doms will fix the error and provide you with a free Application software update. If more than 6 months have passed before you experience an error, then normally you will be charged for the update.

Software Maintenance

Planned software updates regularly provide you with the latest software releases, which often include newly implemented functionality enhancements. These are available when you have a PSS Software Maintenance Agreement, which also extends your standard software warranty for the duration of the valid agreement.

Ad hoc updates are also available. You can purchase an update when it suits you and each purchase will bring you up to a release that contains the latest implemented functionality at that time. If you have a basic software package and find that you want to expand the functionality of your system, you can purchase an upgrade. The upgrade package then provides all the advanced functionality you may require on your site.

PSS 5000 Applications

The PSS 5000 Application software is available as 2 off-the-shelf versions for each platform:

- Basic versions, which support control of dispensers, price signs and ATGs
- Advanced versions, which support functionality, such as attendant tagging and/or performance monitoring, that is required in addition to the Standard version
